Procedure for Directors to seek independent professional advice (Re: Code Provision B.1.4 and C.5.6)

- 1. As part of the mechanism to encourage independent views and input from Directors of the Company ("Director(s)"), a Director, in the discharge of his/her duties from time to time, may seek external independent professional advice to assist performance of his/her duties and request the Company to pay for the independent professional advice for the Director in appropriate circumstances.
- 2. Such request must be made by the relevant Director(s) to the Chief Executive Officer of the Board:
 - (a) in writing; and
 - (b) with stated reasons for the request.

If the Chief Executive Officer is not available to consider such request, it should be made to his delegate.

- 3. The Chief Executive Officer or his delegate will then obtain quotes from at least one independent professional adviser.
- 4. The Board will consider the request and the quote(s) and may resolve to obtain separate independent professional advice to assist the relevant Director or Directors to discharge his/their duties to the Company if the request is considered to be reasonable and appropriate in the circumstances.
- 5. The reasonable cost for the independent professional advice will then be borne by the Company.
